Ava was a scared, sad young girl after her father died unexpectedly. She liked living with her grandparents, but didn't know where she would live long-term and didn't know what would happen to her brothers.

Things got worse when Ava's mom called to tell her she was on her way to take Ava and her brothers to live with her. Ava panicked. She hadn't seen her mom in a long, long time and Ava was still afraid of her mom's boyfriend.

Even though there was a lot of yelling and arguing, Ava was relieved when the police showed up. The police said Ava and her brothers could stay with their grandparents – at least until after their father's funeral.

And this is where you come in! **Thanks to your generous support, Ava and her brothers have an Advocate.** Your support gave Ava exactly what she needed; a person she could talk to about why she was afraid.
